I spoke with staff from the Online Registration Program (OLRP) regarding Reconstructed Vehicle titling procedures for the Out of State Salvage Certificates.

Because not all states participate in NMVTIS (National Motor Vehicle Title Information System), Online Agents are to send the MV-426B Reconstructed Application along with the MV-1 and the Out of State Salvage Certificate to PennDOT for processing.

NMVTIS was designed to protect consumers from fraud/unsafe vehicles and also to keep stolen vehicles from being resold. NMVTIS access is restricted; however, staff at PennDOT are able to access the website and to communicate with other states if there are any questions/concerns with Out of State Salvage Certificates which have been submitted for titling and branding vehicles here in Pennsylvania.

I've been advised that once every state is a participant in NMVTIS, the procedures for processing Reconstructing Vehicles with Out of State Salvage Certificates will be reviewed and reevaluated. Until then, all Out of State Salvage Certificates must be sent into PennDOT for processing.

In order to ensure that the designated procedures are being followed, the Online Registration Program (OLRP) and Reconstructed Unit will be monitoring received Reconstructed Applications with Out of State Salvage Certificates attached.

We appreciate this issue being brought to our attention during the presentation for Reconstructed/Modified vehicles. The above information will also be forwarded to Jo Naccarato for dissemination to those that attended the OLM Association Meeting.
