

Dear PAOLMA Member,

Your **Association** is writing to you today on a very **important matter**. Your **IMMEDIATE ACTION** is necessary!

We need you to **contact** your **State Senators** immediately. We need you to **meet** with **them** in person (preferred) or on the phone **by June 4th, 2022**.

The effort to bring back the registration sticker for the benefit of the citizens of Pennsylvania is at a critical point. The **Commonwealth is losing 10 to 15 million dollars per year** due to vehicles being unregistered.

Please ask your state senator to contact Senate Majority Leader Kim Ward and tell her the following:

1. They support putting the registration sticker back on the plate with no cost increase to registrations as is written in Kim Ward's SB 410.
2. Include language in the budget bills to return stickers to the license plate when the budget is voted on.
3. Discuss the attached talking points with your State Senator.

WHY SUPPORT SB 410 AND HB 334? REGISTRATION STICKERS ON VEHICLE LICENSE PLATES

- PA has lost over **\$71 M** in actual and projected vehicle registration revenue since 2017
- PennDOT requests **\$164 M in 2022** in new state funds to match federal BIL funds
- PennDOT requests **\$930 M** in new state funds over 5 years
- PennDOT will have **\$9.3 B** in Unmet Annual Needs in 2022
- PennDOT will have **\$14.5 B** in Unmet Annual Needs in 10 Years
- The General Fund must pay **\$450 M** annually to replace Turnpike contribution
- PA continues to suffer actual losses in vehicle registrations while surrounding states see annual growth in registrations during same period (VA, OHIO, MD, NY)
- TFAC Report of 2012 estimated elimination of stickers would save **\$1.3 M/year**
- PennDOT promised savings from sticker elimination would be used to buy plate readers for municipal police forces—no readers were ever funded by PennDOT
- PA State Police testified they have 6 plate readers statewide—there is no external mechanism to identify vehicles without valid registrations
- Plate readers are invasive to personal privacy and data
- NJ and Connecticut are the only states without stickers
- PennDOT loses revenue on duplicate registrations due to absence of stickers
- On-line and mail registrations will not be eliminated by reissuing stickers
- Increasing numbers of unregistered PA vehicles leads to increasing numbers of uninsured vehicles and motorists
- Law enforcement seeks return of stickers
- On-line Messengers could print stickers as needed thus reducing waste and cost
- PennDOT has continually exaggerated the cost of printing stickers
- As PennDOT demands more funding from the General Assembly the reissuing of stickers could increase revenue to PennDOT
- There are **NO fee increases** for vehicle registrations in SB 410 or HB 334
- PennDOT's annual budget is \$10.1 B while PennDOT only let \$2.1 B in construction contracts in 2021
